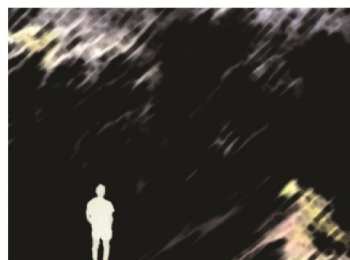
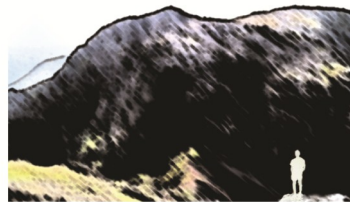
You are cordially invited to the private view for the

This exciting display is organised by second-year Fine Art students from Winchester School of Art and is a response to the announcement by the United Nations of the birth of the seven billionth citizen. It addresses that aesthetic quality of awe-inducing magnitude—the sublime. Each student has contributed their own version of the paintings of Caspar David Friedrich: *the lone figure gazing into a supremely bleak wilderness*.

The students worked with multidisciplinary champions Dr Amos Channon (Ageing and Lifelong Health), Dr Felix Eigenbrod (Living With Environmental Change), Dr John Gillett (Winchester School of Art), Dr Pauline Leonard (Work Futures Research Centre), Professor Gail Taylor (Energy), and Professor Guy Poppy (Director of Multidisciplinary Research Strategy), on pressing issues surrounding population growth, environment and global resources.
